Elgin Close is an Extra Care scheme situated in Hammersmith and Fulham, London.

The scheme enables residents to live independently with access to 24/7 on-site care and support for people over the age of 55. There is a communal kitchen on each floor with a spacious communal lounge on the ground floor to socialise with other residents too. All 36 one- and two-bedroom apartments are available to rent.

Living in Extra Care means you continue to live independently in your new home, exactly as you do now, but with the peace of mind that having help on hand brings. You have your own front door and letterbox; can have friends and family to visit (without asking permission) and can bring your pets with you too.

Elgin Close is located just off the Goldhawk Road, close to local shops and facilities with Ravenscourt Park and Shepherds Bush Market a short distance away. The nearest tube stations are Goldhawk Road on the Hammersmith & City Line and Stamford Brook on the District Line.
