Keen gardeners can look after their own plots in the extensive gardens, which attract wildlife such as foxes, squirrels and birds.

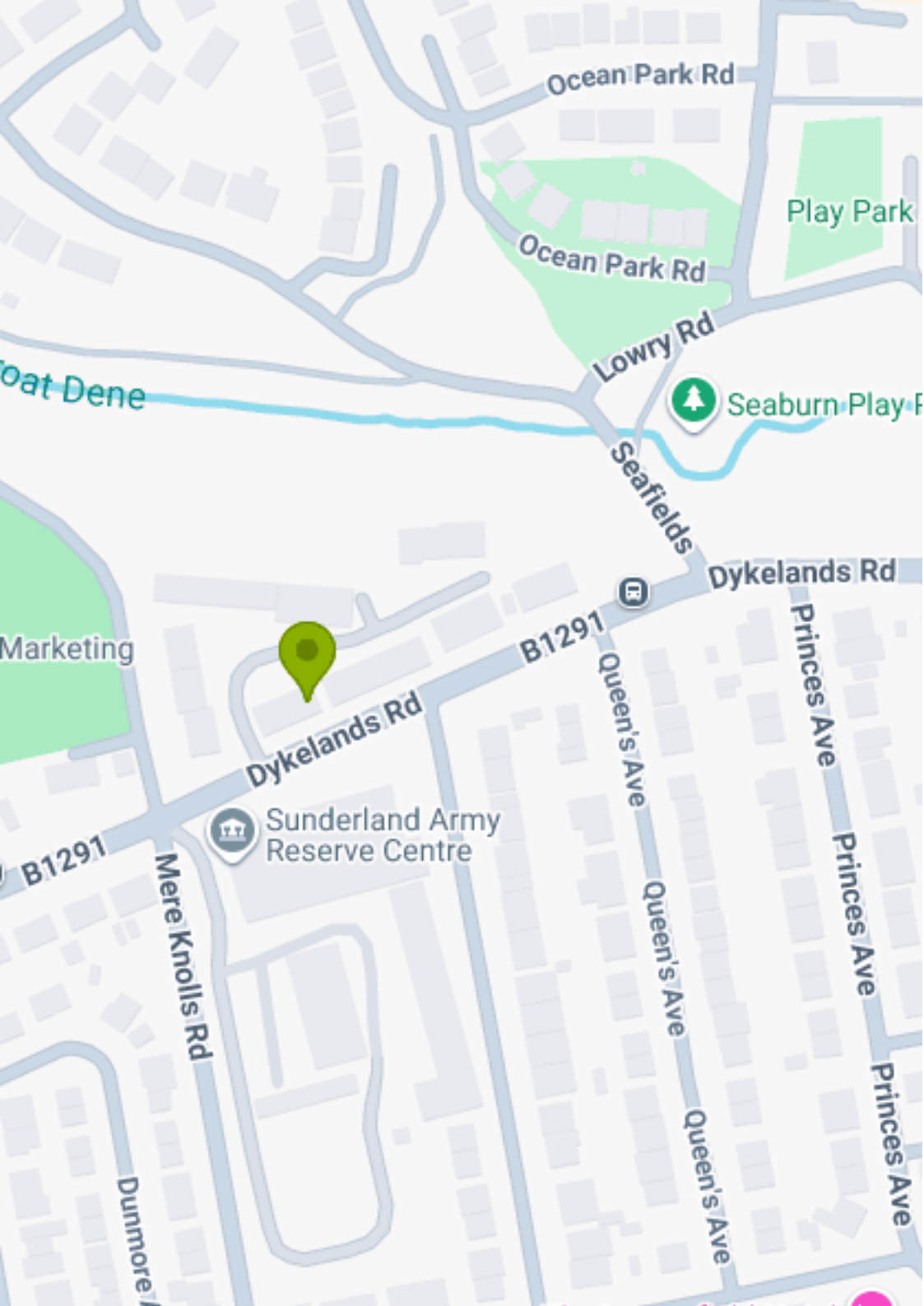
All of the attractions and amenities for Seaburn are close at hand, and the court is just a short bus ride away from Sunderland, South Shields and Newcastle.
