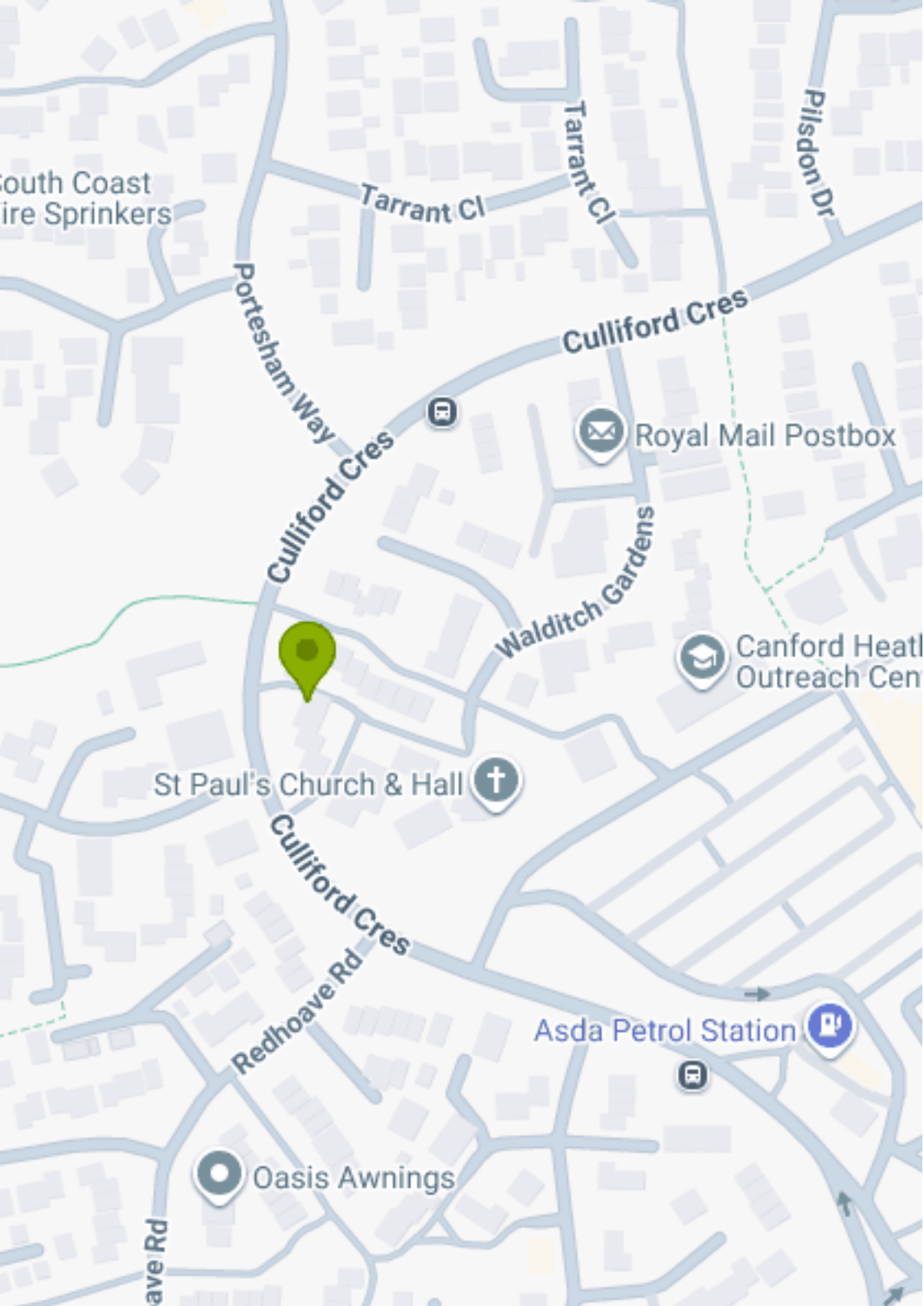
Poole holds a thriving weekly market every Friday and the nearby town of Wimborne holds two markets on Fridays and Sundays.
