Philip Docker Court is set in a quiet village with a close-knit community, just a few miles away from Bedworth, Coventry and Nuneaton.

The village, Bulkington, has a Co-op and some smaller food shops, as well as a chemist, cobblers, craft shop and café. It also has several doctors surgeries and churches, along with a chiropodist, dentist, Post Office, optician and village hall. There are also a couple of pubs in the village centre that serve food. A small park area can be found just two minute's walk from the court.

Bedworth town centre, Nuneaton town centre and Coventry city centre are all just a short car or bus trip away, and each offers a range of shops and amenities, including leisure centres. The nearest cinema and bowling centre can be found on the outskirts of Nuneaton.


