Lawrence Hill Court sits on the outskirts of Gateshead in Tyne & Wear in its own large grounds, complete with a small chapel.

The spacious grounds have won several competitions, and the Residents' Gardens Club makes sure that people living at the court can be involved with activities such as planting containers and baskets, watering and tending to the floral boundaries. The gardens make sure there is a supply of tomatoes for residents during the summer, and host an annual strawberry tea to raise money for charity. Asda, Tesco and Iceland all deliver to the court, and there are four doctors' surgeries and a dentist a short bus ride away.
