Bob Carter Court is situated in the rural village of Mattishall in Norfolk, four miles from the market town of Dereham and 15 miles from the city of Norwich. The court offers residents a friendly atmosphere with everything they need within easy reach.

There are several social clubs in Mattishall ranging from the Women's Institute to crown green bowls, cricket and Zumba. Some activities like the gardening club and friendly club are held at the court while others use the social club in the village.

The nearest bus stop is a few minutes' walk from the court. Residents wishing to travel further afield can access the hourly bus service into Dereham or Norwich, where they can join connections to the national bus services and Norwich train station or airport. Nearby Dereham has a 24-hour supermarket, a good selection of high street stores and regular markets.


