Cleethorpes is also home to a number of annual events, including Cleethorpes Airshow, an Armed Forces Day parade and Cleethorpes Community Carnival.

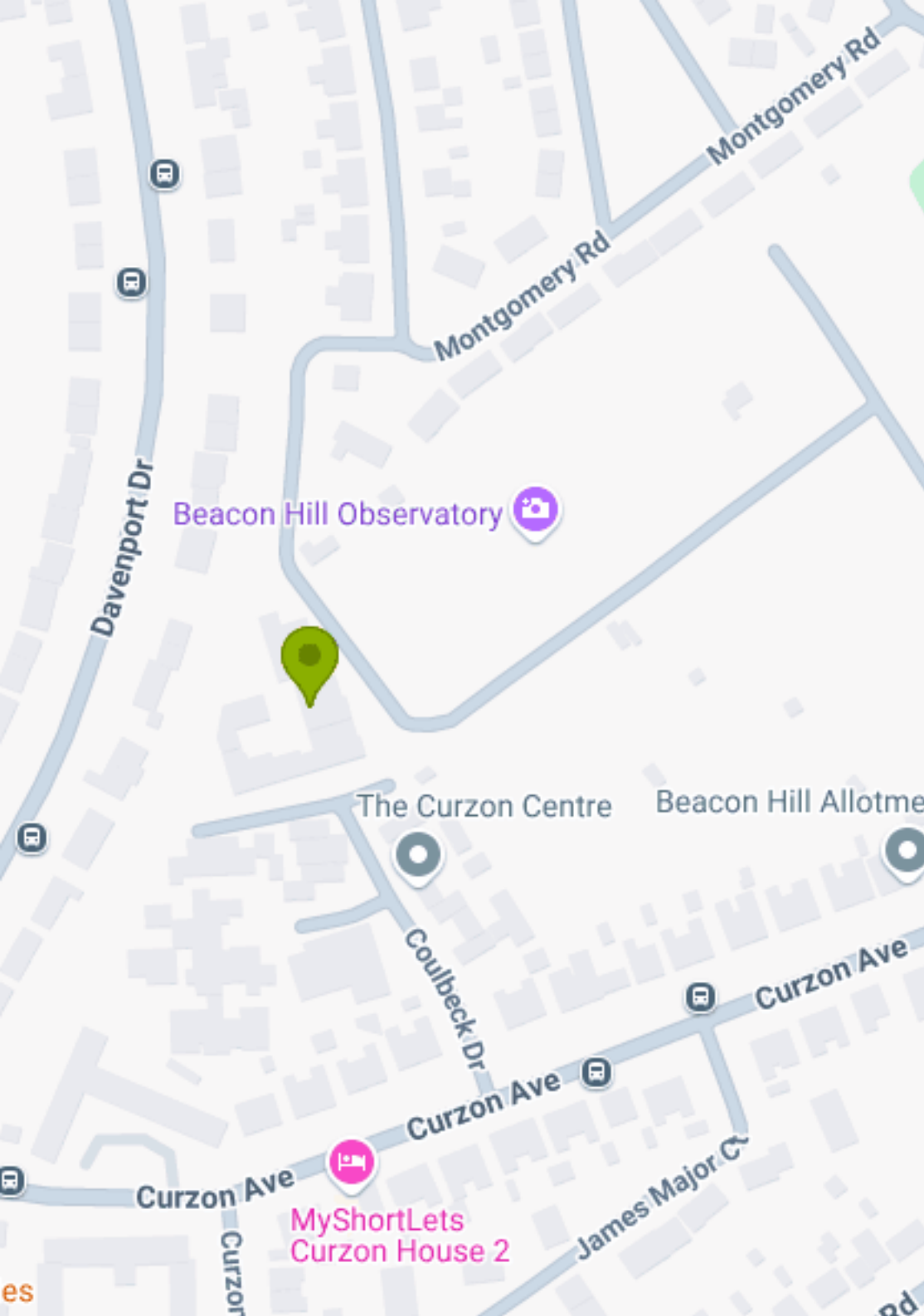
