A bus stop is located outside the court, with frequent services throughout the day, while Bulwell train station is a 5 minute walk away and offers tram and train links to Nottingham and Mansfield.

Colin Broughton Court backs onto the local golf course, and is close to a number of pleasant parks. The court offers a Car park, communal lounge, laundry and well tended gardens – residents are welcome to get involved with looking after the garden areas, or just enjoy the tranquil surroundings. The gardens are also a popular attraction for local wildlife, with regular visitors including foxes, bats, newts, jays and sparrow hawks.
