Freestone Court has a range of on-site facilities for residents, including a communal lounge, laundry, guest room, bathroom, library area and movie corner.

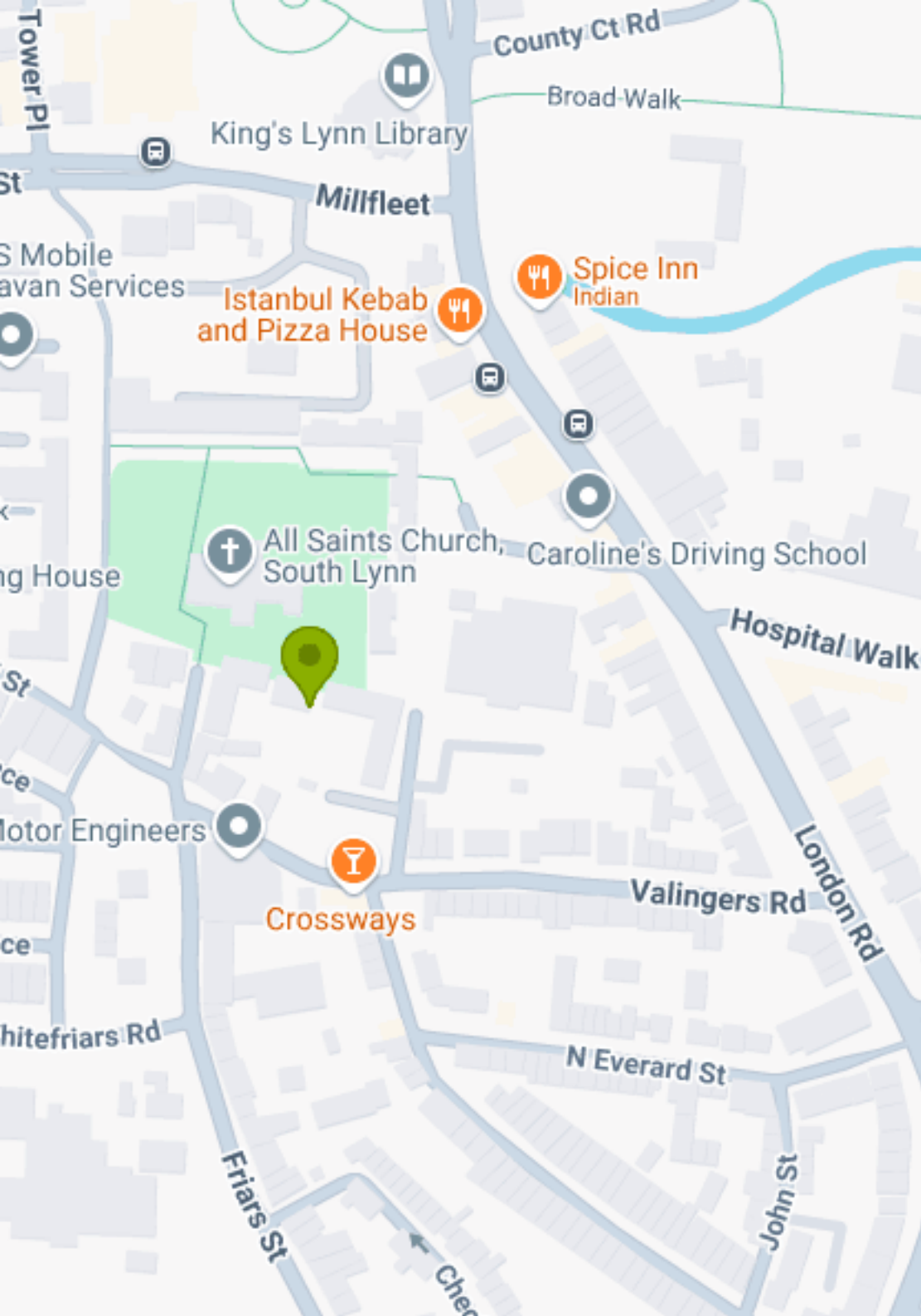
