Situated on the outskirts of Herne Bay in Kent, King Edward Court is a highly sought after scheme which is within walking distance of the sea.

Residents at King Edward Court benefit from an on-site hair salon, gym, kiosk shop, activity room and internet café. The scheme is surrounded by beautifully maintained gardens with raised flower beds, gazebo and arbour; there are also bird houses in situ.

Buses run every 20 minutes from outside the scheme, and the nearest train station is a 30 minute walk.
