Situated in Moredon, a quiet area of Swindon, Maple Court is just 10 minutes bus ride from the town centre and 5 minutes from a designer outlet village.

A couple of minutes walk in either direction will lead you onto a rural trail with old railway tracks. Public transport is very accessible with a bus stop just round the corner from the court and a train station in the town. Just across the road there is a post office, medical centre, convenience store and pub, and just a little further by bus there are a collection of supermarkets.

Outside Maple Court you will find a communal garden with decking and patio areas as well as secure parking onsite. The gardens are age friendly and often full of wildlife.

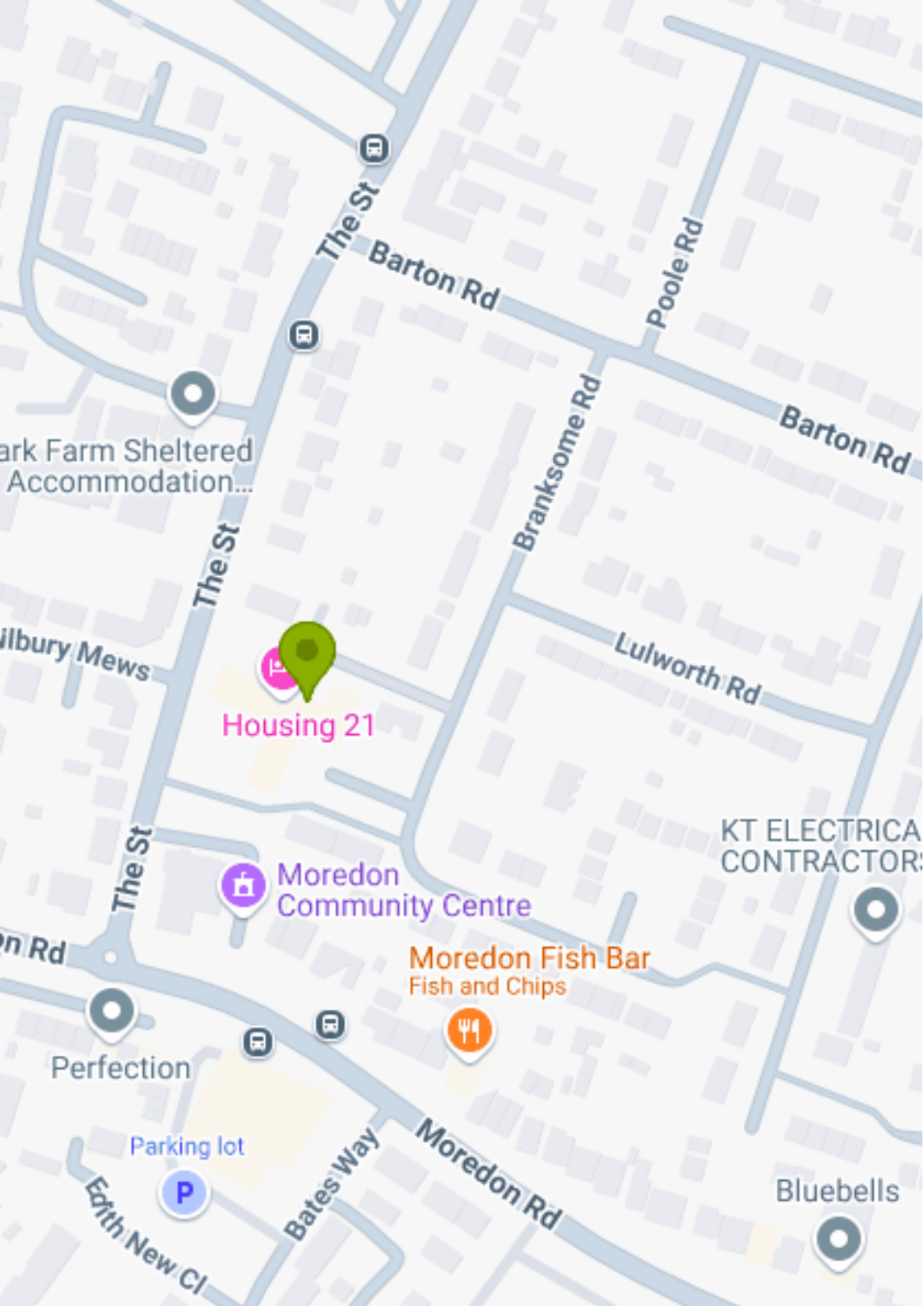
