The court offers 40 one and two bedroom self-contained flats, with two on the ground floor adapted for residents with disabilities, and access to personal care. There is wheelchair access throughout the properties.

It is within easy travelling distance of Saltwell Park, which has extensive grounds, a lake and an information centre. It is also just a small distance from Gateshead town centre, Newcastle city centre, and the North Sea coast.


