Rokeby Gardens is a friendly and inviting court with a community feel, located in the village of Kirk Sandall. The court is just three miles from the centre of the lively and historic market town of Doncaster.

There is plenty for residents to do in nearby Doncaster, with a general market three days a week and a good selection of pubs, restaurants, gyms, golf courses, a cinema and theatre.

Popular attractions include the famous Doncaster Racecourse, Conisbrough Castle, Cusworth Hall, the Yorkshire Wildlife Park, Brodsworth Hall and the Dome leisure centre, where you can go skating, swimming or bowling.

Buses run every 20 minutes from a stop close to the court and will take you into Doncaster or the nearby villages. A mainline train station is just half a mile from the court and provides connections to the wider rail network. Many residents choose to use the community bus and there is also a local taxi offering disabled access transport.
