A Court Manager is on hand to provide help and support to residents, and each apartment is fitted with a 24-hour emergency alarm.

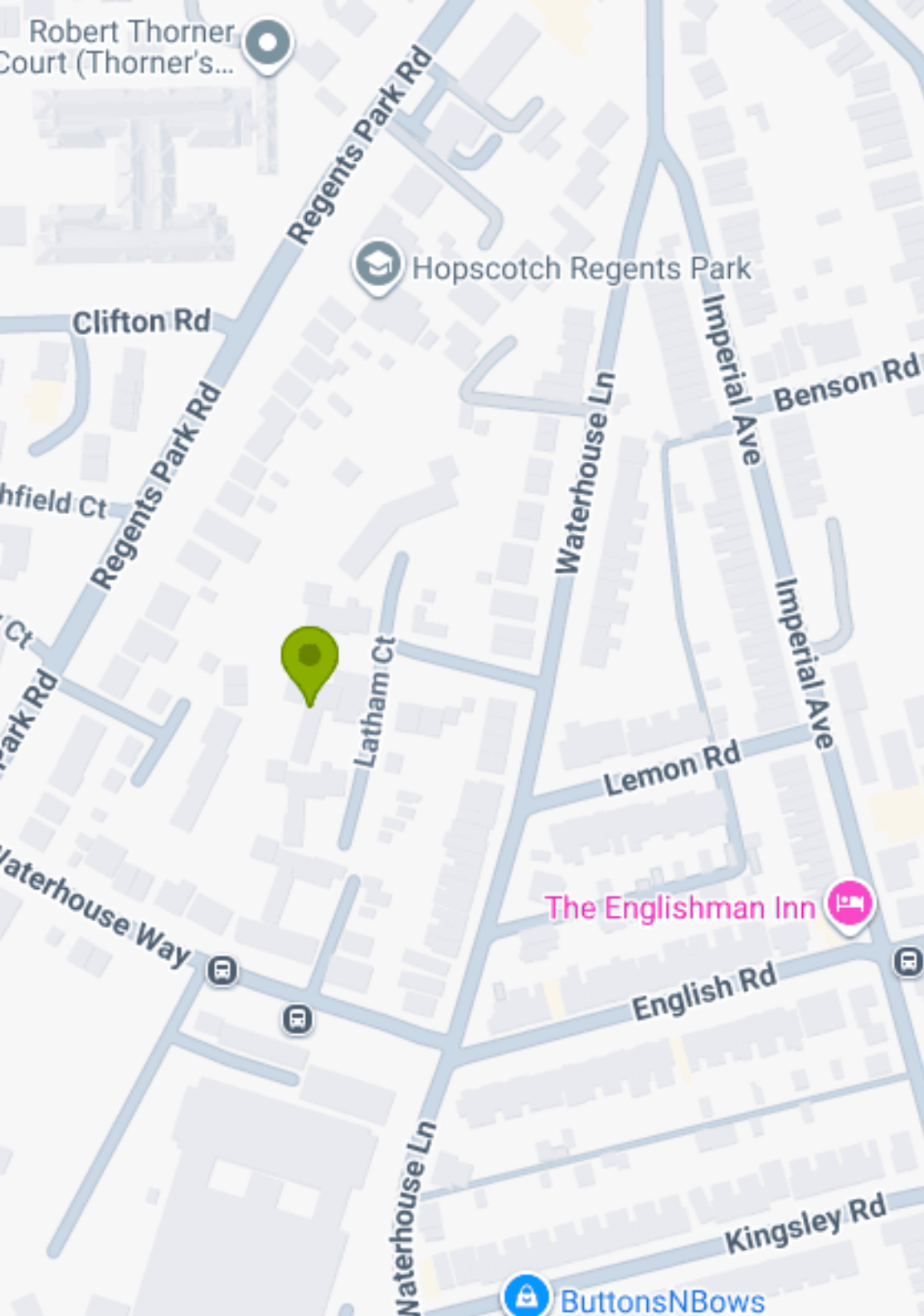
Please note that there are no two-bedroom flats available at this court.
