The Wirral peninsula offers a wealth of beautiful beaches and open countryside. The historic city of Chester with its Roman heritage is only 20 miles away.

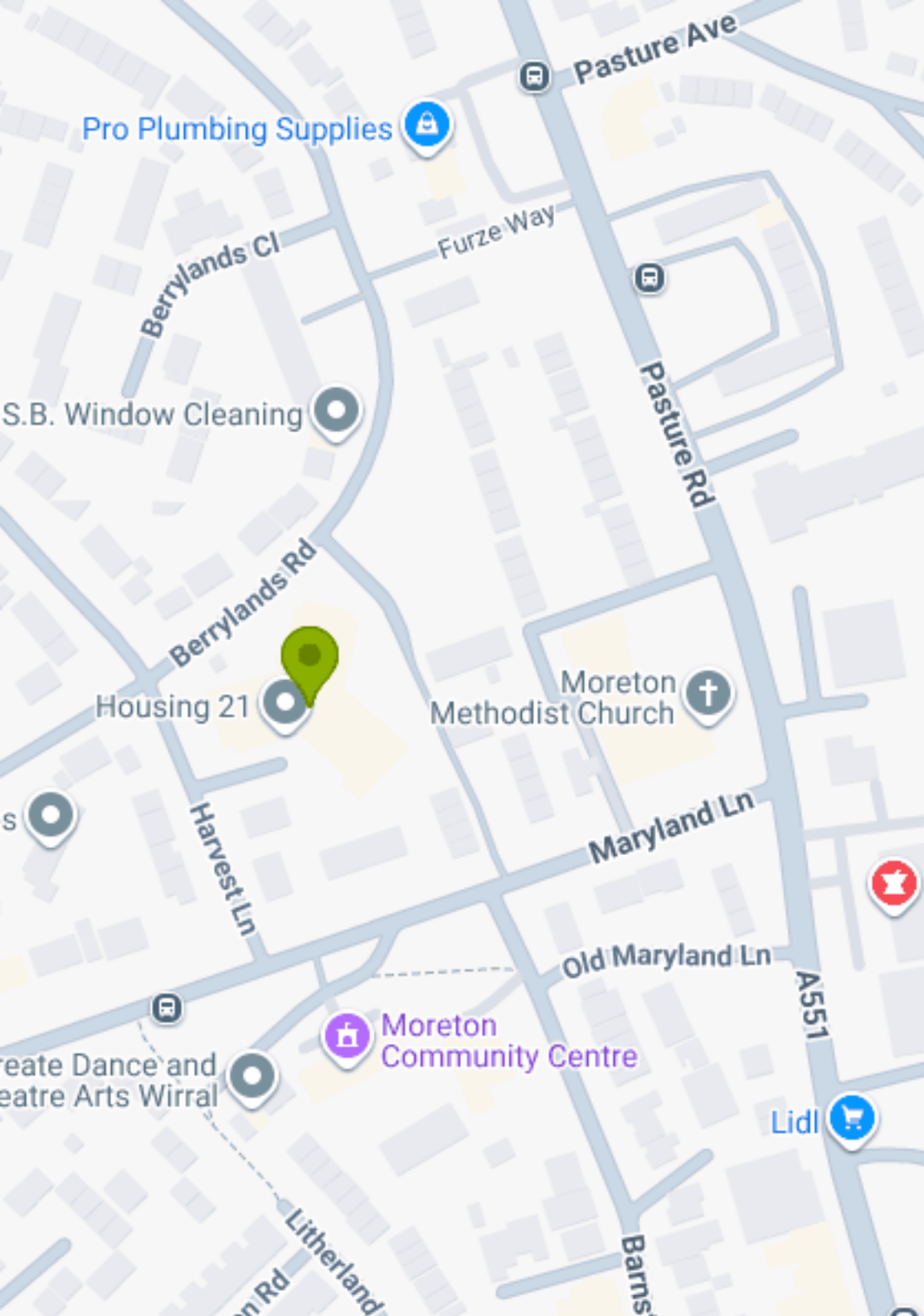
