Willow Gardens is an Extra Care scheme in Chipping Norton.

The scheme offers independent living with access to on-site care for people over the age of 55, with 80 one-and two-bed apartments available for social rent and shared ownership.

Willow Gardens has been designed to provide fully accessible facilities for both residents and visitors, which include a café/bistro and hair salon for use by the community. There is also an assisted bathing suite, an activity room, a residents' lounge and communal gardens for residents to enjoy. Pets are more than welcome to move in too. As well as support from our specialist team, the scheme is managed by a dedicated on-site local manager.


