

COVID-19 New Government Guidance

To control the spread of coronavirus (Covid-19) the Government announced new national lockdown measures, which come into force from **Thursday 5th November 2020**. These restrictions include:

- Staying at home other than for specific reasons including work (where you cannot work effectively from home) and exercise.
- Non-essential shops, hairdressers and leisure centres will close.

There are three simple actions that we must all continue to do to keep on protecting each other:



HANDS

Keep washing hands regularly



FACE

Wear a face mask/covering in enclosed spaces



SPACE

Maintain social distancing - stay at least 2 metres (6'6'') apart from people outside of your household or support bubble

For Housing 21 residents, these changes mean that:

- The management team will continue to work on site to provide support and services.
 - Statutory health and safety works and essential repairs will continue.
 - All communal facilities including communal lounges and gardens will be for resident use only.
 - You should only have essential visitors to your home and those who form part of your support bubble.
 - Dining areas will be closed and where applicable restaurants will offer a takeaway meals service only (for collection or delivery).
 - If residents are using the communal facilities, 2 metre social distancing will apply at all times.
 - All Housing 21 staff and any contractors will continue to wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) in resident's flats and communal areas at all times.
 - Guest rooms will not be open except for exceptional circumstances
 - Hairdressers will be closed.
