Stanbridge House is located in the peaceful Easington area of Banbury in Oxfordshire, enjoying good transport links and easy access to a range of local amenities.

Banbury is a lively and attractive town where there is always something going on. The town holds weekly markets and there is a variety of events including the popular annual canal day, the Hobby Horse Festival and the Banbury Town Show.
