Wellington Court, situated in Pellon in Halifax, is a lively community and has recently had new kitchens fitted in each of 36 flats. Also the communal block has had a complete new makeover.

On-site facilities at the Court include a guest room, a communal lounge with a fully equipped new kitchen and a laundry room.

Across the road is a hairdressers, post office, newsagents and social club. There is also a regular bus service just outside the Court which goes into Halifax and to the Calderdale Royal Hospital every ten minutes. There is a local G.P practice and a large supermarket five minutes walk away from the court. In all there are 22 studios, 14 one-bed apartments and 1 three-bed apartment.
