Nearby leisure facilities include a large and attractive park, a library and several pubs, as well as a cinema and a social club at the community centre opposite the court. Hewden Manor, the Chiltern Hills and nature reserves are all within close reach, while farm shops in Prestwood offer the opportunity to pick your own strawberries and enjoy afternoon tea.


