Cinnamon Court is an Extra Care scheme in Deptford in South East London which offers easy access to New Cross, Greenwich and the River Thames.

The court is just five minutes' walk from Deptford high street and 10 minutes from Greenwich by bus. Both areas have a wide range of shops, pubs, supermarkets, cafés, churches and leisure facilities. Deptford holds a thriving market three times a week while Greenwich has a popular covered market on most days.

The area is well-served by public transport, which in turn gives excellent access to Central London, Greenwich, Surrey Quays and Lewisham shopping centre. Deptford station is located in the high street and provides services to Woolwich, Dartford, Gillingham and mainline London stations including London Bridge, Waterloo East, Charing Cross and Cannon Street. There are many reliable taxi companies and a dial-a-ride service in the area.

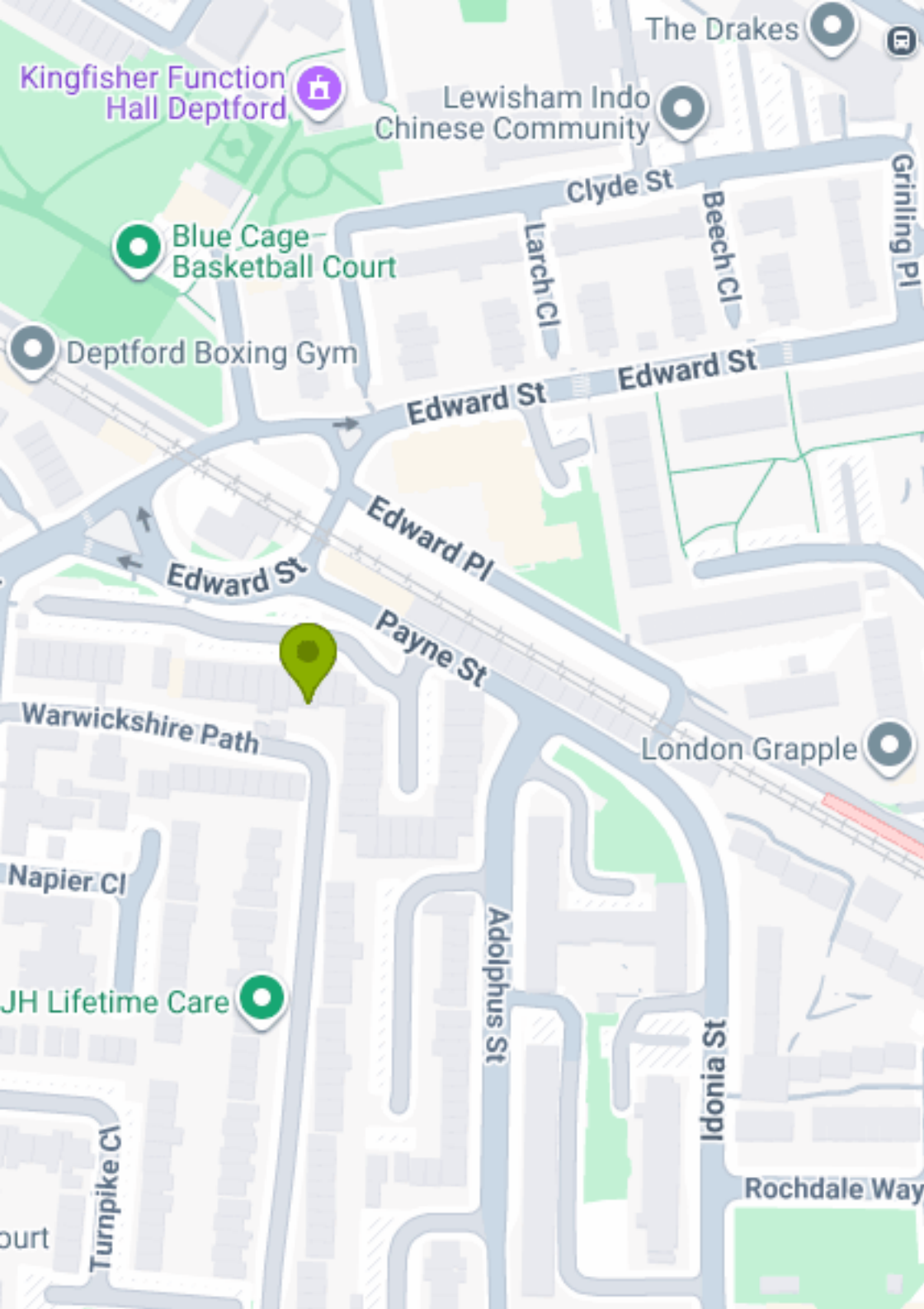
Local tourist attractions include the world-famous Cutty Sark, Maritime Museum and Royal Observatory.
