Richard Onslow Court enjoys an attractive setting in Monkmoor, a peaceful part of Shrewsbury in Shropshire. The historic town is close to the River Severn and boasts over 600 listed buildings.

The town centre is just three miles from the court and offers plenty for residents to do. Shrewsbury market hall is open four days a week and nearby Quarry Park holds a variety of events including concerts, flower shows, fairs and circuses. Shrewsbury has many attractions including a theatre, leisure centre, cinema, bowling alley, pubs, restaurants, cafés and National Trust properties.

There is a good range of local amenities within 10 minutes' walk of the court including a newsagent, post office, chemist, small supermarket and hairdresser. Larger supermarkets, banks, doctors surgeries and dentists are a short bus ride away.

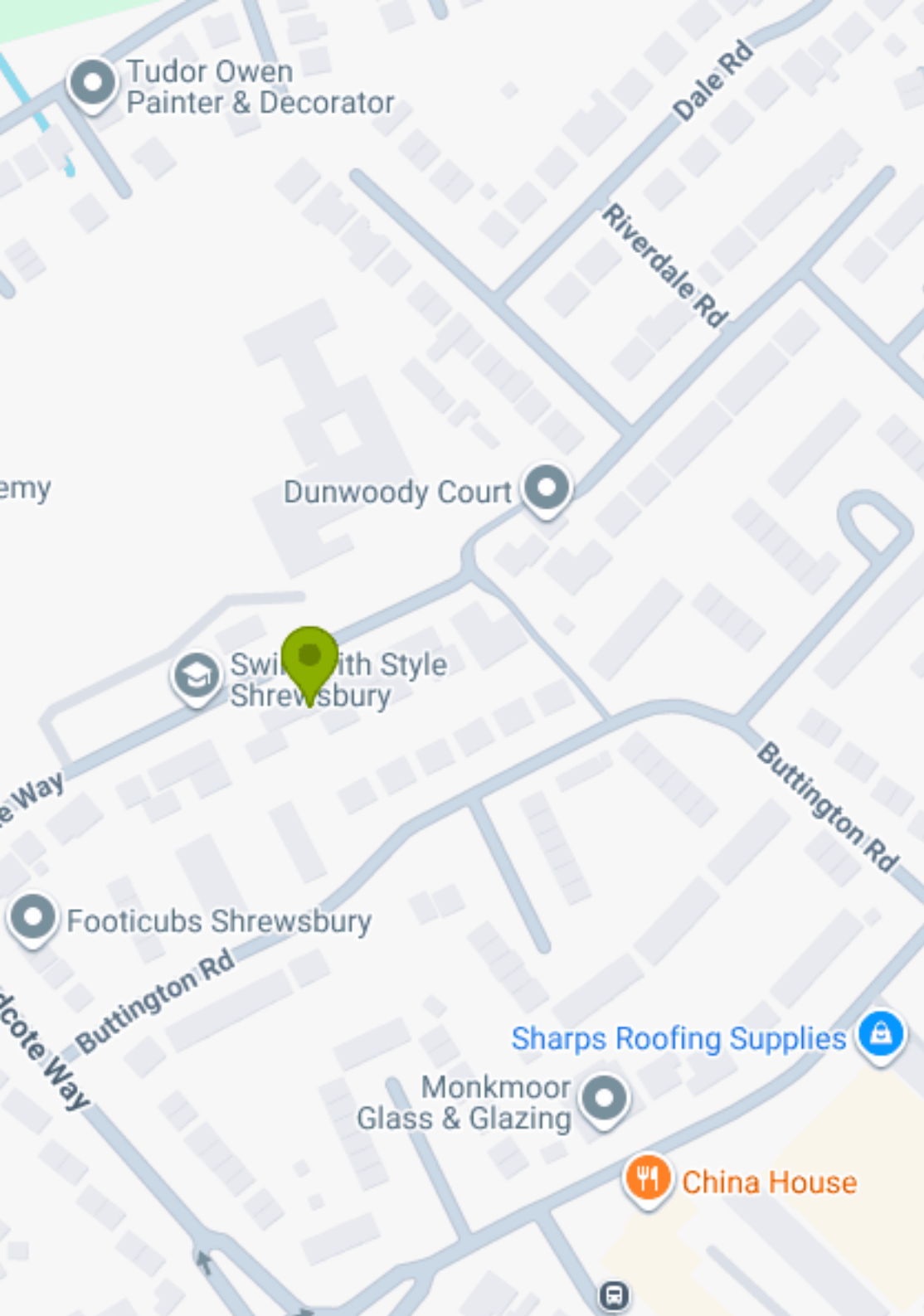
