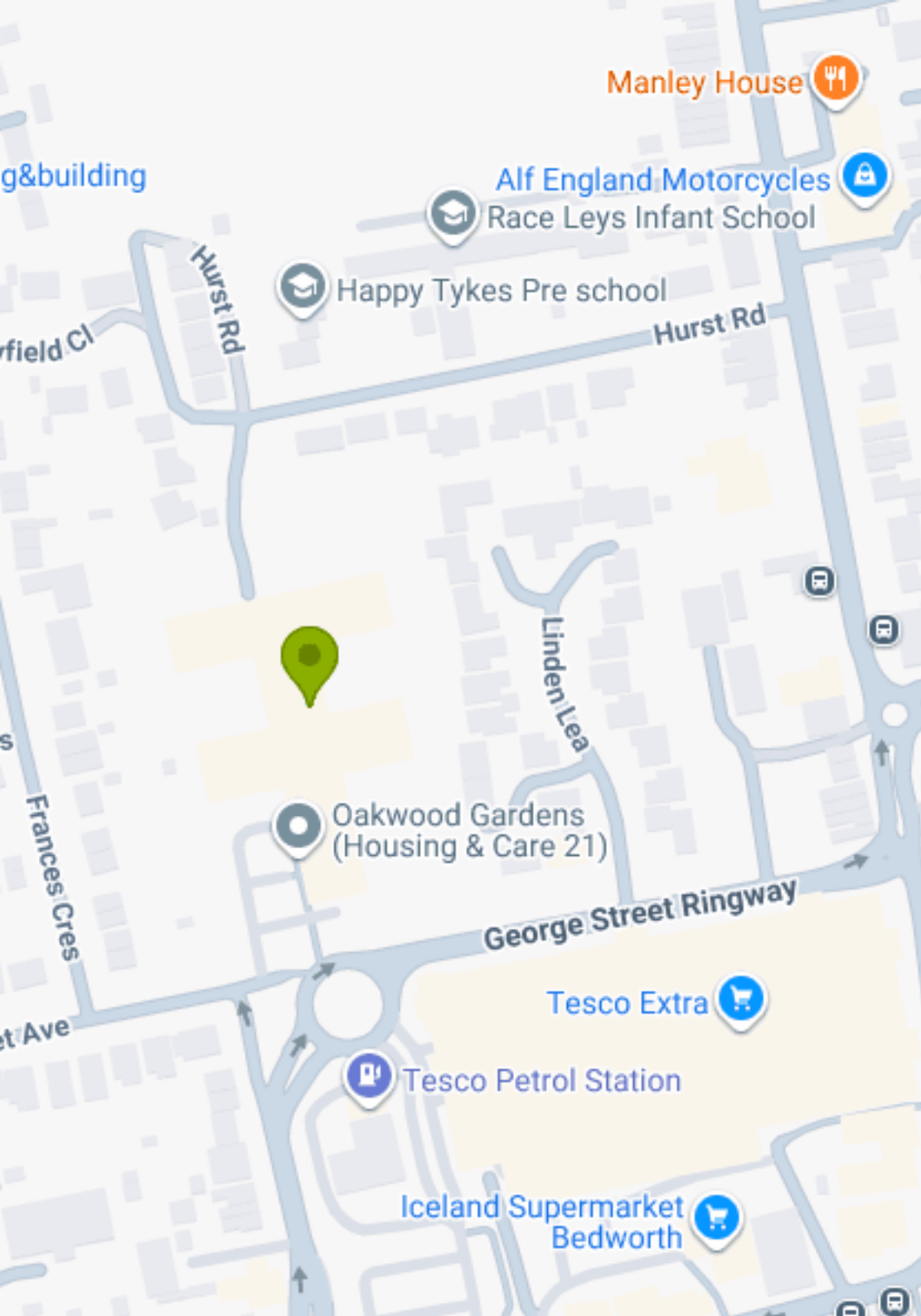
Care staff are based on-site 24 hours a day, and there are also full-time court staff to support residents.
