Brown Court is surrounded by farmland just half a mile from the centre of Ashby-de-la-Zouch in Leicestershire. The court is close to the National Forest, public footpaths, cycle paths and walks along the canal in nearby Moira.

There is a nearby leisure centre with indoor and outdoor swimming pools and sports hall offering regular classes and activities. Residents can also enjoy the nearby small park and Moira Furnace which has a small museum and shopping area offering local crafts. Conkers and Twycross Zoo are a short drive away and there are cinemas in nearby Swadlincote and Burton on Trent.

The Beeches Public House and Restaurant is about 5 minutes walk away, and there are plenty of places both in Ashby town and locally to get good quality food at a reasonable price.

Ashby-de-la-Zouch holds many events, such as the monthly farmers market and a popular food festival. Nearby Moira also holds events along the canal-side. Conkers has regular concerts and Ashby has its own small theatre. The Ashby agricultural show is held in July and brings many people to the area.
